Cutting Taxes

As your next State Senator, my first priority is to lower your taxes.

In Fulton County, most property owners received surprisingly high property tax bills last year and this Fall which hurt our families and put many of our seniors at risk. It is time to establish a firm cap at 2.5-3% on our property tax assessments for ALL portions of our property tax bill, including the school tax portion. Additionally, it is long past time for Fulton county seniors to have what Cobb county seniors have had since 2000 – a senior school tax exemption. Stable property tax assessments allow our neighbors to reliably plan their budgets, and a senior school tax exemption promotes stable neighborhoods – our neighborhoods.

I support tax incentives to lure out-of-state investment to Georgia, but we must also bolster our homegrown Georgia businesses and families. We can afford to reduce state income taxes and other hidden taxes, permits and fees for everyone. I will work aggressively for an immediate reduction of our state income tax rate this session for all Georgia individual taxpayers by at least another 0.5%.

It's time to deliver pro-growth TAX REFORM to Georgia, and I will make this a priority as your next State Senator.
